### Ministry Update

It has truly been a crazy year so far. I know many times we write about all the good things that have been happening through our emails and newsletter updates. But ministry is not easy much of the time, and although many good things continue to happen with the ministry, there are many attacks that are part of what we do. The Bible says in Ephesians 6 that our fight is not with flesh and blood, but it is a spiritual battle. Yes, we increased our full-time staff from 1 to 2 last year, yes, we moved from 52 services a month (642 a year) to 88 a month (1,071 a year), but it was not without a battle. We need you to stand by us in this battle, please pray for us, volunteer with us, and support us financially.

*I can't tell you how much I appreciate you sending Pastor Keller to the residents. I specifically remember him saying one day that he was going to talk about "Love" and he has done so each time he has come to us; gentle kind love. Not only does he come to us, but he also brings his young daughters and occasionally his younger niece. At the course I took to become a certified activity director I was told that there are three things that one can be sure will touch residents if nothing else will; animals, music and children. The residents delight in seeing his young daughters, and the last time he came he even asked if anyone would like a hug from his daughters. My residents don't often respond when asked a question but this didn't matter, the girls came forth, reaching out to these wonderful elderly people and I think each one was hugged. This touched me deeply, and I know it did much more for the receivers of Pastor Keller's outreach. It seems Pastor Keller "knows" what to say. Especially last Monday, he talked of being persecuted for ones beliefs. This came to me at a time when I was about (once again...this happens occasionally) to resign from my position. So you can see, he touches more than just the residents. Again, Mr. McKenzie, thank you.*

We are seeing staff, nurses, and family members at Assisted Living Facilities and Nursing Homes get saved and ministered to in addition to the residents. We are also mentoring two men who have been locked up previously, a couple of hours a week, every week that goes by to help them make it out there. We have even seen staff at Correctional Facilities get saved. One man in particular had reached bottom in every area of his life and is now in church every week he is able, and when he can't, he brings his tithe by so that he won't spend it somewhere else. His life has been completely changed.
