His Love Ministries Mission

For almost 6 years His Love Ministries has been dedicated to reaching out to those people, whom the world has forgotten. Our mission is to spread the gospel throughout prisons, jails, correctional transition centers, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and the local community. To reach more people with the life changing message of Jesus Christ. To equip and edify those who know Christ as their Lord and Savior. To build greater relationships with those in need by providing joy, comfort, and security in their lives through bible studies, church services, correspondence, and site visits.

I would like to give praise to our wonderful Lord and Savior who has allowed this Ministry to be the instrument used in 257 professions of faith so far this year.

His Love Ministries currently provides 16 services a month (192 a year), at nursing homes/assisted living, the Savannah Men's Transitional Center, Effingham Prison, Candler Hospital, and the Chatham County Jail. We also provide short devotionals on His Radio 91.9 FM. In addition we do supply preaching. In December we will be going to 18 services a month (216 a year).

Special Update



We are praying for more partners to continue the ministry full time. Since mid March I have been working full time with the ministry. We still need 30 more people for the next year that will commit to give at least \$20 a month. To give this much to help others is to sacrifice one meal a month for a family, one trip to the movies, and less than it costs to fill up most cars at the gas station.

Every inmate who's life is changed by Christ and stays out of the penal system saves us (the taxpayer) money. The average cost of incarcerating an inmate is \$20,000 a year, even if only one gets saved a year, we have one less person on the street that is capable of stealing, hurting, or even killing someone. If we keep one inmate from committing more crimes and being locked back up again, we have saved the taxpayers \$20,000, and almost recouped the cost for one year of ministry. This money spent to make our community safer is well spent. We want to help change our community with your help.

As of November 2003 we have been going to Nursing Homes and providing services for over 4 1/2 years (April 27, 1997).

22 of our 257 professions of faith come from the Nursing Home/Assisted Living Ministry.

- You can adopt a Riverview (Formerly Chatham) Nursing Home resident, put a tract and/or card in the gift and even participate in the party as your gift is given to a resident.
- Below you will see a name, a number, and to the far right the size.
- You can either give a pullover or zippered robe or sweater.
- If you can buy it, wrap it, and let me know how you want to get it to the Nursing Home that would be best. I will come get it, if you need me to.
- Each robe or sweater will cost about \$20.
- If you want to donate financially to this project you can do it in the name of His Love Ministries; it is tax deductible as allowable by law.
