Praise the Lord, God is still opening doors. I was able to start a church service at another Assisted Living Facility, Generations of Batesburg-Leesville in March. The Activity Director who used to work at another facility I minister in asked me to come. I am going now twice a month. We've had great services with joyful singing and attentiveness by the residents. I also received some crocheted shawls and was able to give them out at another facility. It was a great week with 4 services in 3 days.

We are seeing some more interest now in Coastal Harbor with two men who hopefully will be teaching the boys shortly. I always thought the only way we would be unable to minister to facilities was because of them not wanting the Gospel to come in. I never thought a virus would render us helpless and unable to get into some facilities. Many places we go to are still requiring masks and vaccines. Some have eased up on restrictions, and are allowing exemptions on vaccines and no masks as long as we don't get too close to residents. I really miss the days when we could hug people, shake hands, pat someone on the shoulder and help them find the right pages in the hymnals we use, but most places still won't let us to do those things.

We are thankful for the opportunities we do have to spread the Love of God where He allows us, and praying more facilities will ease up on their restrictions.

We started a daily devotional on our ministry page and my personal page along with the daily bible reading program. Our podcasts have been listened to 962 times in 35 states and 28 countries.

We still need at least a couple of men to teach for church services in the Nursing Homes/Assisted Living Facilities and also help in Coastal Harbor for Adults in Savannah. We could also use some women to come alongside them to help in a supporting role. I want to challenge those who are retired, semi-retired, or those who could make time to help us reach these who cannot get out to churches and Bible studies. COASTAL HARBOR GIRLS

As we continue to teach weekly Bible studies at Coastal Harbor we can see God work. Below are several examples of how God is working in the lives of the girls.

Several of the girls who were faithful in attending Bible study have been discharged from CH, leaving a void in the unit.

Some of the remaining Bible Study participants told us about a couple of the girls who were faithful to read their Bible and pray with and for the girls in their unit. The remaining girls missed those girls who had read their Bible and prayed daily. They also noted how the atmosphere had changed in a negative way after their departure. They realized what a positive impact their prayers had been on the unit as a whole and them individually.

We remember the day we met “A”. She looked so sad and lonely. She sat by herself in the corner. We asked her to join us for Bible Study and she did. She came and never missed for 8 months. She always sat quietly, but began to change a few months ago. She started reading aloud during Bible Study and started reading the Bible by herself also. She started with Genesis and by the time she was discharged she had read through part of Joshua. We share the Good News of Jesus to girls who have never heard the Gospel. On the other hand, there are girls who used to go to church before they were admitted to Coastal Harbor who come to our Bible Study also. They have renewed their faith in Christ. Sometimes they ask other girls to join Bible reading and prayers.
